



Confidentiality Policy for Pregnancy

Sunshine Sunflower Foundation is committed to offering a confidential service to individuals. Any discussion within the organisation will be purposeful, sensitive and respectful.

No information about a young person will be given to a third party, even if the party is a member of the young person's family. Information will only be passed onto another agency with the full and informed consent of the young person. The young person has the right to withhold consent. The Charity will however conduct a risk assessment and modify activities accordingly.

Young people under 16 are encouraged to discuss the issue with their parent / guardian / carer where it is safe to do so.

Sunshine Sunflower Foundation will break confidentiality if:

there is cause to suspect that a child under 18 is at risk of suffering harm, or
the young person has threatened to do serious harm to themselves or others, or
the young person gives information which indicates a possible terrorist attack.
